It is my pleasure, on behalf of the Department's Executive Resources Board, to announce the participants in the Department's new FY 2003/2004 Senior Executive Service Candidate Development Program (SESCDP). The program was announced Government-wide and all GS/GM-14s and 15s were eligible to apply. Over 200 applications were received. Each of the participants have been notified and congratulated on this important accomplishment.

The attached list provides the name, occupation, and organization of the participants. All participants will remain in their current positions and will complete their development activities on a part-time basis over a 9- to 15-month period. Once they have completed the program, they will have their leadership competencies certified by the Office of Personnel Management. This certification makes program graduates eligible for non-competitive selection to Senior Executive Service positions for which they are technically qualified.

Within the next few weeks, more detailed biographical data concerning each participant will be forwarded to all organizational elements. This information is designed to help identify candidates for potential rotational assignments within DOE organizations.

I would also like to congratulate those applicants who were referred to the SESCO DP Assessment Center interview process, but not selected. It is important that we, as the senior leadership of the Department, make every effort to assure their continued leadership development. I strongly encourage each of you to provide developmental opportunities for those whose leadership potential has been identified through this selection process.

An orientation program for the SESCO DP participants has been scheduled for November 3-7, 2003, in Washington, DC.
